According to the number of entries, we reserve the right to change the number of participants or to cancel the event.

The evaluation takes place in the quadruple competition and cross-country in 8 classes:
m/f up to 14 years, m/f 15 to 18 years, m/f 19 to 49 years and m/f 50 years and older.

The allocation of the teams shall be based on the principles of the Testing Regulations of the German Kennel Club (VDH) 2019.

For 2022 the following applies:

Youngest class: born 2008 and younger
Youth class: born between 2007 and 2004
Active class: born 1973 to 2003
Senior class: born 1972 and older

In all other respects, the competition will be held in accordance with the current VDH Testing Regulations for Tournament Dog Sports.

If more entries are received than there are places available, the performance principle will decide.

According to the performance principle, each federation sends its best (per country) quadruple jumpers/cross-country runners / Combination Speed Cup teams (CSC).

A contingent of 10 starting places is initially reserved for each type of competition.

According to the performance principle, unused starting places will be distributed among the other countries.

[Proof of valid rabies vaccination and membership of the dog handler and dog owner in the respective association/club].

The cross-country competitions will take place on 23.07.2022. The quadruple competitions will take place on 23. and 24.07.2022.

The CSC competitions (qualifying rounds and finals) will take place on 23 and 24 July 2022.

General conditions: Combination Speed Cup (CSC)

Youth class: all starters in the sections born 2004 and younger

The qualifying time is a maximum of 70.00 seconds for adult teams and 80.00 seconds for youth teams.

Unused starting places, youth or adult, will be filled with the respective other age groups.

On Saturday the CSC teams will have 2 qualifying rounds to determine the qualification for the following finals (best time 8 youth and 16 adult teams).

Qualification period: from 01 January 2021 until the registration deadline

Entry deadline: 29 May 2022 (date of receipt of digital entry).

Registration office: Entries must be accompanied by copies of the fulfilled eligibility requirements. The final entry list will be published in June 2022.

Entries must be sent through the formal channels of the participating federation (including, if applicable, the federation's own entry deadline).

Direct entries from individual members cannot be accepted.
